PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

NOVEMBER 2019



In November I take time to reflect and to remember. November 11th is Remembrance Day, we remember the more than 2,300,000 Canadians who have served throughout our nation's history and the more than 118,000 who made the ultimate sacrifice. This day holds special meaning for me, as my late husband Charlie's Grandfather, Wilf Renner served our country in the Second World War. He is featured in the book by Ian Darling *Amazing Airmen: Canadian Flyers in the Second World War*.

Wilf and his crew were in a Halifax Bomber JD463 when they left Middleton St. George in Northern England on October 4, 1943. The mission was to bomb the Frankfurt railway yards, and Wilf was in the nose of the bomber responsible for pressing the button to release the bombs. The mission was completed but the Halifax Bomber was detected by search lights. Wilf Renner was the only survivor when the Halifax Bomber JD463 was struck down by a German night fighter.

Wilf landed in a wooded area of Belgium after being blown out of the Halifax Bomber. Wilf was very lucky to be alive and he encountered Father Laboulle who was supporting the Belgian Resistance to the German forces. Father Laboulle took Wilf in and had a doctor come in to help Wilf with the injuries he sustained when he was shot down. Back in Preston, (Cambridge) Ontario Wilf's Parents John and Louise Renner received a telegram that the plane failed to return, and their son was missing in action. Another notice came about six months later that he was presumed dead. His parents and his fiancée Elizabeth Pullbrook never lost faith that Wilf would be found alive. During his stay with the priest, Wilf was told that he needed to leave as the Gestapo were searching the area. The information was accurate, because within hours, the Gestapo arrived and took Father Laboulle away for questioning, he was held for a week before being released.

Wilf Renner was taken in by a woman named Maria Dardenne who lived in Fairoul, Belgium. She was an enthusiastic supporter of the Resistance; her brother had been wounded by German soldiers during the first World War. Gangrene had developed in his legs and she took care of him until he died. She was offered money to help shelter Allied soldiers in the Second World War, but she didn't accept anything, she just wanted to help anyone who risked their lives fighting Nazi Germany. Maria hid Wilf for the winter months, and by mid-April Wilf joined the local Resistance known as Secret Army Zone 1C60. The main job of the men in the group was to collect the supplies that the Royal Air Force dropped by parachute. The supplies included such items as Guns, ammunition and cigarettes. On June 6 (D-Day) the men at the camp learned about the Allies landing on the beaches of Normandy. In September the Air Force finally told Mr. and Mrs. Renner the happy news, it had been almost a year, but his mother always believed he was alive. Wilf arrived back in Preston on October 31, 1944, and less than a month later he married Elizabeth. They were married for 68 years until her passing in 2012. Wilf lived to 95, and he passed away in February 2015. This is just one of millions of stories of the brave Men and Women who have fought for our freedom. On November 11, please take a moment to remember and wear your poppy with pride. Be thankful you are a Canadian and you live in this wonderful country.
